

**BOARD OF FORESTRY AND FIRE PROTECTION**

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**Status Report****April 19, 2006****Project name: Amador Plan, 2006****Project Type: Regulatory Action**

A proposed regulatory amendment to Title 14 CCR section 1261 regarding cooperative agreements for non-fire season services. These agreements are termed "Amador Plan Programs" agreements and provide non-fire season emergency services to local government jurisdictions. The proposed regulation establishes personnel assignment levels, cost apportionment formulas, and expand the types of local entities that may contract for the services. The proposed regulation is necessary to implement legislative amendments to Public Resource Code (PRC) 4143 and 4144 authorized under Senate Bill (SB) 1356 of 2004, and to update the regulation based on Board and California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CDF) policy changes.

**Status:**

- Staff revisions were presented to the Board's Resource Protection Committee (RPC) at the regular Board meeting on April 4, 2006 (in Alpine, CA). Board directed staff to make amendments and renotice for a 45 –day period for public hearing.
- Notice of hearing and regulation amendments were published on April 19, 2006. Public hearing will be held on June 8, 2006 in Los Angeles County at a location and time to be announced.

**Milestone and Timeline:**

- Board hold public hearing on June 8, 2006 and adopt, amend, or return to committee proposed regulation.
